Guidelines of the Paleontology Association of Georgia Scholarship Program sponsored by the members of the Paleontology Association of Georgia

#### This application is for students interested in paleontology

- 1. The Paleontology Association of Georgia propose to award two \$250 scholarships for each calendar year to qualified students enrolled in secondary or post-secondary education in Georgia. Each year officers will determine the number of scholarships based on monies available.
- 2. Eligible to apply are high school or college students who are citizens of Georgia. The scholarship must be used for internships, research, or conference attendance of the calendar year.
- 3. The scholarships will be awarded to students with a specific interest in paleontological sciences.
- 4. Selection of the recipients will be based on scholastic ability and good citizenship in school and community. The decision of the PAG Scholarship Committee is final and not subject to review.
- 5. A letter of reference from an unrelated party (employer, teacher, counselor, mentor, etc.) is required in order to be considered.
- 6. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the recipient upon satisfactory completion of the application and requirements and notice of award. Recipient shall ensure that scholarship funds be used solely for the stated purpose intended. If the recipient is a minor, parents or guardians are responsible for proper expenditure.
- 7. Scholarship recipients must submit at least photographic evidence ("selfies") of the funds in use. Photographs may be used on the PAG website and social media sites.
